

Similkameen Trip

Hi Everyone,

Here is all the information you need about the Similkameen River trip. I tried to make everything as clear as possible but feel free to call us if you have any questions or concerns about the trip, 604.983.6663.

The River & Your Gear

There are sections for every level of paddler on this river. We will run mostly beginner and intermediate runs. The campsite is the take out for all runs. We will do 2, possibly 3 runs per day.

We will bring a bunch of boats, paddles and skirts with us. You are responsible for bringing all of your personal paddling gear, top, wetsuit, helmet, pfd, etc. You can come by the shop at any time to pick this stuff up.

Please let us know your plans are so we know we have the right boats for you.

Directions

1. Head **east** on **HWY-1 E** toward **Hope**
2. Continue on **Hwy 3 E/Hwy 3B E** this will take you through Manning Park (do NOT take the Coquhalla Hwy)
3. Continue on **HWY 3/HWY 3B** through Princeton, this is pretty much your last stop for gas, food etc.
4. Destination will be on the right. It is 32.6 km from the Dairy Queen in Princeton. You will cross over to the East Side of the Similkameen River then slow down! There will be a fenced in utility station on your left, take the small dirt road on the right and head down to the river. We will be there in the R.V trailer. If you hit Keremoes you've gone too far
